

SCRATCH PUG

(Our puggy take on a beloved classic!)

You'll need: paper, printer, scissors & brads



Print (8.5x11", portrait orientation) your pug on sturdy stock, then cut out!
Don't worry about cutting perfectly; a little white around the edge is perfect!



With a pin or tack, poke through the white holes!



For each set of legs, put one behind the body & one in front!
(The tail can go on top or behind.) Line up the holes!



Poke a brad through each 'stack' at the 3 hole locations!
Secure the brads on the back of the pug.



Eeeeeek!
